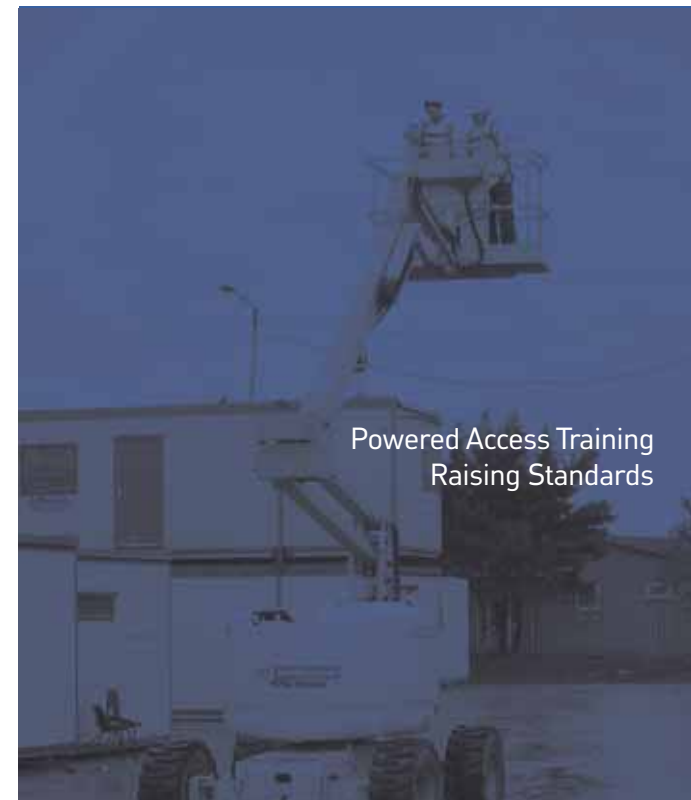

Courses are run at our IPAF Approved Training Centre at Avonmouth near Bristol, or at one of our satellite training centres conveniently located to provide extensive coverage of mainland UK. Alternatively training may be conducted at the Customer's premises subject to certain conditions being met.

Loading and Unloading Course

Duration is generally 1 day depending on type(s) and number of machines to be included in the course syllabus and the previous experience of attendees.

Harness Training Course

Duration is generally between ½ and 1 day depending on type(s) of harness/fall arrest equipment and previous experience of attendees.

Operator Course

Duration is generally 1 day depending on number and type(s) of equipment and the previous experience of attendees. The number of attendees permitted to attend each course varies depending on the type(s), number of machines and whether trainees are novice or experienced operators.

Demonstrator Course

Duration is generally between 2 and 3 days depending on the type(s) and number of machines to be included in the course syllabus and the previous experience of the attendees. Trained operators may attend a demonstrator course without first having to serve 'an apprenticeship' as an operator.

Instructor Course

Duration is generally 5 days and includes an Instructional Techniques Module. This particular course must be conducted by a senior IPAF instructor. Attendees must, except in exceptional circumstances, have 36 months operator experience prior to being considered for instructor training.

Course Syllabus

Each training course is structured in a similar fashion. The training syllabus will always include the following:

- >> Course Presentation
- >> Written Test Paper
- >> Instruction on Chosen Category of Machine
- >> Physical Test
- >> Course Evaluation
